

WIND DAMAGE: SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING



Examples:

- Some shingle damage
- Few broken windows
- Cosmetic damage to siding
- Repairable

AFFECTED

WIND DAMAGE: SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING




Examples:

- One (1) wall damaged
- Section of roof missing or damaged
- Repairable

MINOR

WIND DAMAGE: SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING




Examples:

- Substantial structural damage to walls, roof, etc.
- Repairable

MAJOR

WIND DAMAGE: SINGLE FAMILY DWELLING




Examples:

- Total Loss
- Structure is compromised
- Not repairable

DESTROYED

WIND DAMAGE: MOBILE HOME




Examples:

- Minor dents to roof or siding

AFFECTED

WIND DAMAGE: MOBILE HOME




Examples:

- Utility connections broken
- Slight movement on piers/
foundation

MINOR

WIND DAMAGE: MOBILE HOME




Examples:

- Wall and roof damage
- Shifted on piers/foundation

MAJOR

WIND DAMAGE: MOBILE HOME



Examples:

- Total Loss
- Bent Frame
- Buckled walls, roof
